



DAILY PRAYER OUTLINE

- I. Enter prayer with thanksgiving and praise (Psalms 100:4, Psalms 95:2)
- II. Acknowledge dependence on Jesus, daily.
- III. Offer up prayer and thanks for men (and women) in authority and government officials. (I Timothy 2:1-2)
 - A. Thank Him for provision, protection, healing, and conviction of sins for all kings, presidents, and government leaders.
 - B. 10/40 window countries and all nations of the world for receptivity to the gospel.
 - C. Send laborers to the harvest (Matthew 9:36-38)
 - D. Give us the heathen for our inheritance (Psalms 2:8)
 - E. Pray for the peace of Jerusalem (Psalms 122:6)
 - F. Pray for the unborn and pro-life cause
- IV. Thank Him for provision, protection, healing, and encouragement for:
 - A. Immediate family and not-so-immediate family members (also for salvation)
 - B. Church leadership
- V. Pray for miracles, healings, gifts of the Spirit to function; supernatural moves of the Spirit in our services
- VI. Thank Him for each week:
 - A. 10 being saved
 - B. 10 being filled with the Holy Ghost
 - C. 10 healed/ delivered
 - D. Packing out each church service (surrounding churches too)
 - E. Necessary finances to carry on His work and expand our parking lot.
 - F. Thank Him for dissolving your personal indebtedness
 - G. Thank Him that:
 1. You have abundance and no lack
 2. For prosperity (Psalms 35:27 and Deuteronomy 8:18)
 3. That He has redeemed you from the curse of the broken law (Galatians 3:13,29)
 4. For favor (Psalms 5:12)
- VII. Offer up personal worship and minister to the Lord as part of your devotional time
- VIII. Pray our local church vision (see bulletin)
- IX. A prayer outline will help keep you focused on a daily basis, and to not be distracted from your Christian walk.
- X. Acknowledge to Him your desire to be led by the Spirit. (Romans 8:14 and Colossians 3:15)
 - A. Seek Him for direction daily (Psalms 9:10, Lamentations 3:25)
 - B. Ask for His plans

Additional Prayer Items:

Esther 5:8 - petitions are granted by civil authorities.

Psalms 44:3 - battles will be won in which God fights for me.

Exodus 3:21 - restoration of everything the devil has stolen.

Exodus 11:3 - honor in the midst of adversity.

Deuteronomy 33:23 - increased assets in real estate.

Joshua 11:20 - great victories in the midst of great odds.

Esther 2:17 - prominence and preferential treatment.

Zechariah 10:1 - send the rain (of the Spirit) in the latter reign.

Romans 10:1 and Psalms 122:6 - prayer for Jews.

Colossians 4:2-4 - for doors of utterance.

II Thessalonians 3:1-2 - for ministers, missionaries, and evangelists.

Colossians 1:9-11 - (Philippians 1:9-11) - for saints to grow up and mature.

Ephesians 1:17 - for yours and others eyes to be enlightened.

Jeremiah 31:16-17 - for your children.

Ephesians 3:14 - for salvation of a loved one.
